Agreement of Conduct

- ☆ Be aware of and conform to all camp policies and procedures;
- ☆ Understand that the use of tobacco, drugs or alcohol will be grounds for dismissal from camp with no refund of tuition;
- ☆ Assume that until a rule is waived or altered it remains in effect;
- ☆ Be willing to volunteer information in matters relating to the health, safety and welfare of others;
- ☆ Dress appropriately for camp and all activities as well as out-of-camp trips;
- ☆ Assist the camp staff in operating a safe program;
- ☆ Avoid inappropriate language and behavior. Bullying is not tolerated;
- ☆ Understand that there is a need for supervision and accountability of your whereabouts in camp and on out-of-camp trips;
- ☆ Ask permission to leave the bunk for any reason and return promptly;
- ☆ Help keep all camp areas clean;
- ☆ Protect and properly care for all equipment used in any camp program;
- ☆ Be aware of the daily schedules and take responsibility to be on time;
- ☆ Wear a seatbelt when provided in vehicles and refrain from behavior that would be disruptive to the driver;
- ☆ Understand the use of cell phones and other electronics are prohibited;
